Jesus and Me is a fun time for children held on Sunday mornings. JAM meets on the second and fourth Sundays of each month. JAM children come into the first part of the service and then go to the hall for their own activity time. This usually involves making something around a Bible theme or story. At the end the children bring the work they have done back into the church to show the older people.


