

## AN UNEXPECTED LESSON FROM AN UNUSUAL SOURCE:

### THE KILOGRAM

Late last year it was reported that, unlike most of us as we grow older, the Kilogram is losing weight. Since 1889, the international Prototype Kilogram, made out of platinum and iridium and kept in an underground vault in Paris, has been the standard by which all Kilograms are judged. Yet now, for reasons nobody quite understands, the so called Perfect Kilogram has been weighed, measured and found wanting. In fact, scientists have meet together to discuss its replacement.
